Instructions

- (1) The form is used to nominate candidates of Vice Chair and TC Members. Terms of the candidates are:
 - Vice Chair: Vice Chair 2027
 - Members: 1/1/2027–12/31/2029.
- (2) Candidates can be self-nominated or nominated by current Members.
- (3) Candidates must be current IEEE and SPS Members in good standing.
- (4) Vice Chair candidates are restricted to individuals who are currently serving or have previously served as elected members of the BISP TC. The Vice Chair position automatically succeeds to the position of Chair from 1/1/2027. The term of office of Chair and Past Chair is two calendar years.
- (5) Vice Chair candidates that are part of the Nominations and Elections Subcommittee are required to withdraw from the subcommittee.
- (6) Member candidates must be willing to review papers within the area of the BISP TC submitted to SPS conferences, review papers for workshops owned or co-owned by the BISP TC, serve in BISP TC Subcommittees, and perform other duties as assigned.
- (7) Members whose first term ends this year, may be nominated for a second consecutive term, but are not eligible to vote and shall not be part of the Nominations and Elections Subcommittee.
- (8) The list of current Members and Associate Members is attached for convenience. Members whose term ends this year are highlighted in **green** if they are eligible for re-election, or in **red** otherwise. Associate Members may be nominated to become a Member at any time.
- (9) Past Members who already served for two terms or more, may be nominated if their last term ended at least 3 years ago, counting from 1/1/2026. See the BISP TC website under Past Members for the complete historical list of names and terms.
- (10) The primary nominator is responsible for gathering and filling in the information on the following pages *completely* before submitting the nomination form. Nominators are encouraged to check with the Nominations and Elections Subcommittee Chair whether their candidate has already been nominated. If so, nominators may be asked to team up in order to strengthen the nomination.
- (11) Save this form using *Save* or *Save As...* (do **not** *Print as PDF* as this will prevent automatic parsing).
