

Bylaws

1. **Name**

Computational Imaging (CI) Technical Committee (TC)

2. **Purpose**

To promote activities within the technical area of computational imaging, distinguished from image processing by the role of computation in the image-formation process.

3. **Governance**

The CI TC is governed by the Bylaws of the IEEE Signal Processing Society (SPS), the SPS Policy and Procedure Manual, and any policies and procedures enacted by the CI TC. In the event of conflict between CI TC policies and procedures and those enacted by the SPS, the SPS policies and procedures take precedence.

4. **Fields of Interest**

The fields of interest of the CI TC shall be those that are listed under all EDICS categories of the *IEEE Transactions on Computational Imaging* and under the EDICS subcategory Computational Imaging of *IEEE Transactions on Image Processing*.

5. **Scope of Activities**

- a. Assist in the review of papers submitted to SPS conferences
- b. Organize and operate independent workshops, or sessions at technical meetings of the SPS
- c. Make nominations for SPS awards
- d. Assist selection of SPS Distinguished Lecturers
- e. Assist Editors-in-Chief of SPS publications (transactions, letters, and magazines) in recruiting qualified Associate Editors
- f. Assist in the development of appropriate IEEE standards within scope, according to the rules and procedures of the IEEE
