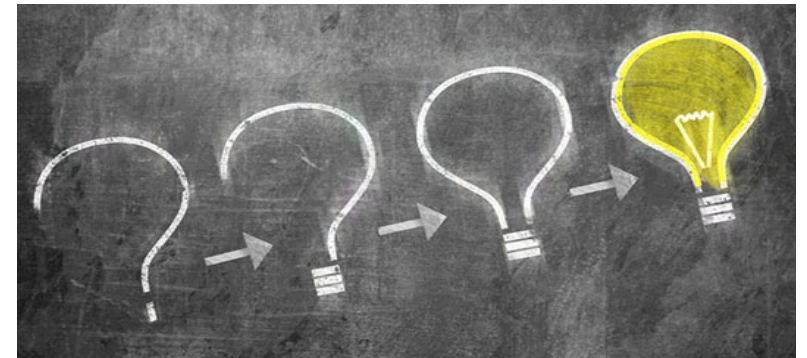

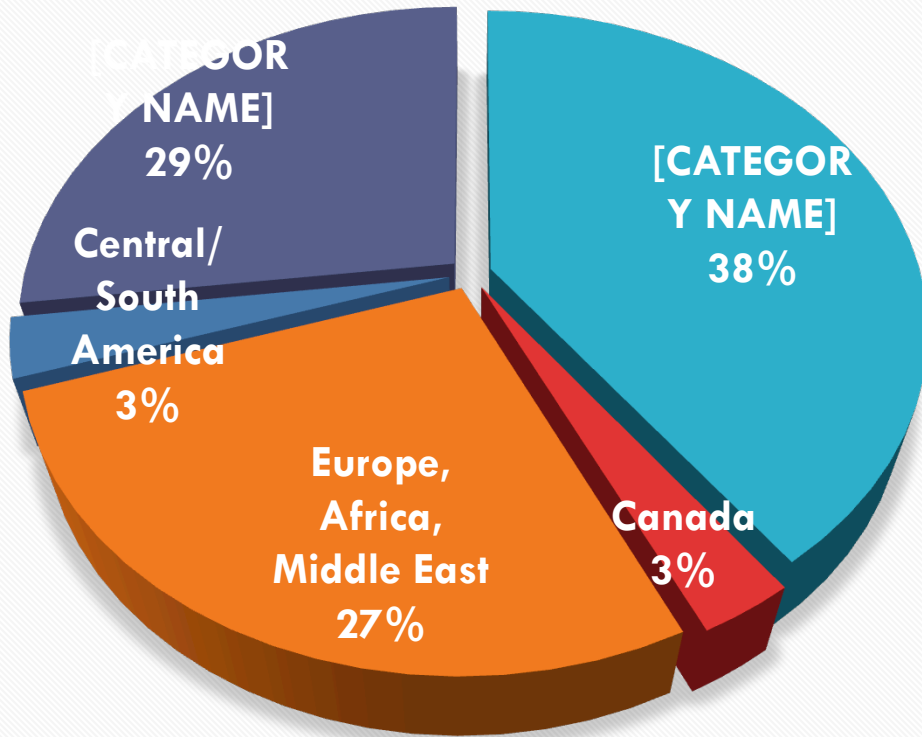

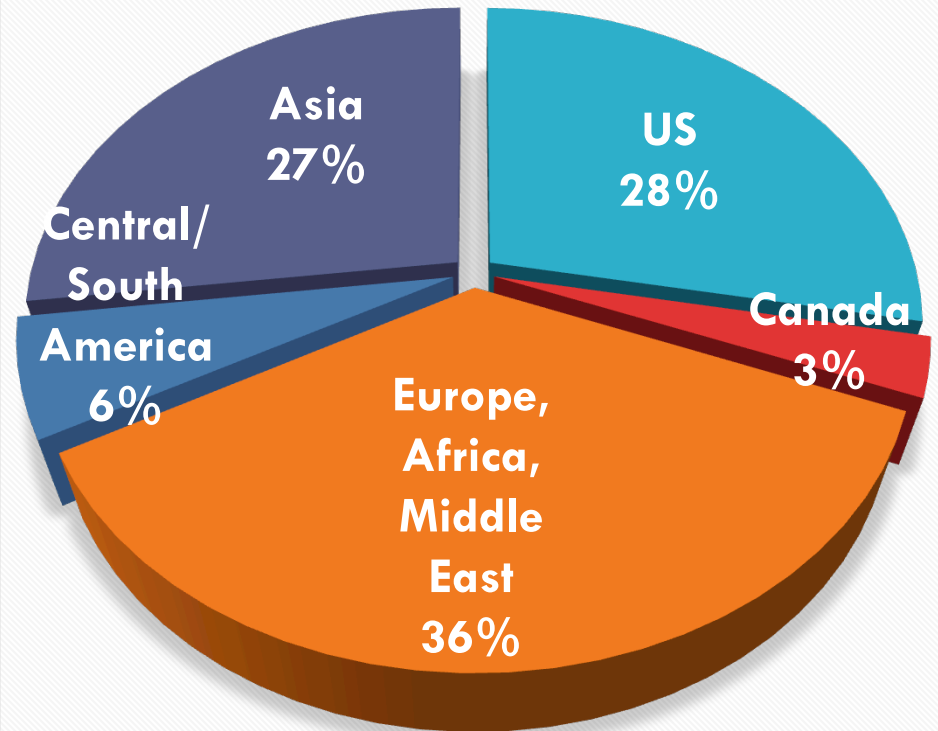

Participation in Elections

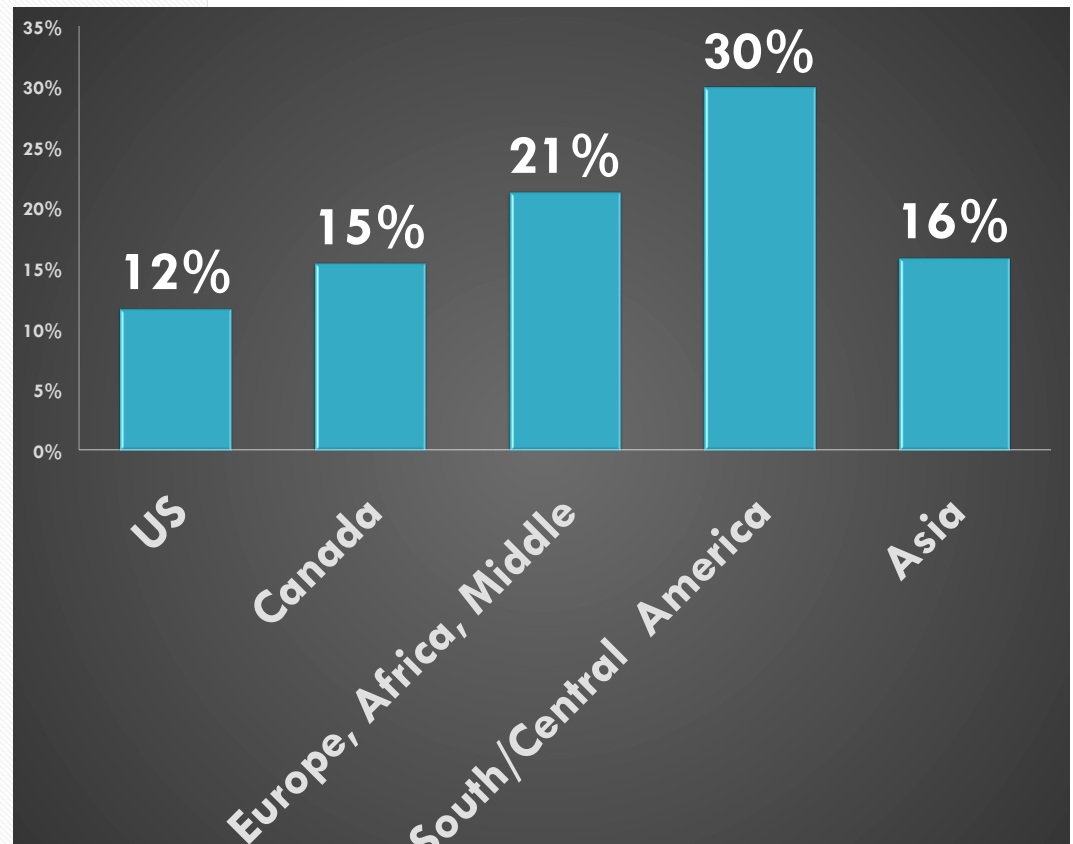


Origin of Votes

Percentage of Members Participating in Voting from each Region

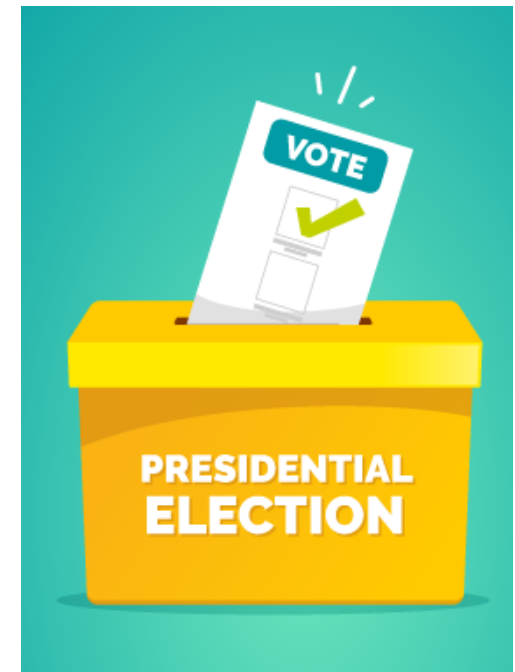


Election of Society President

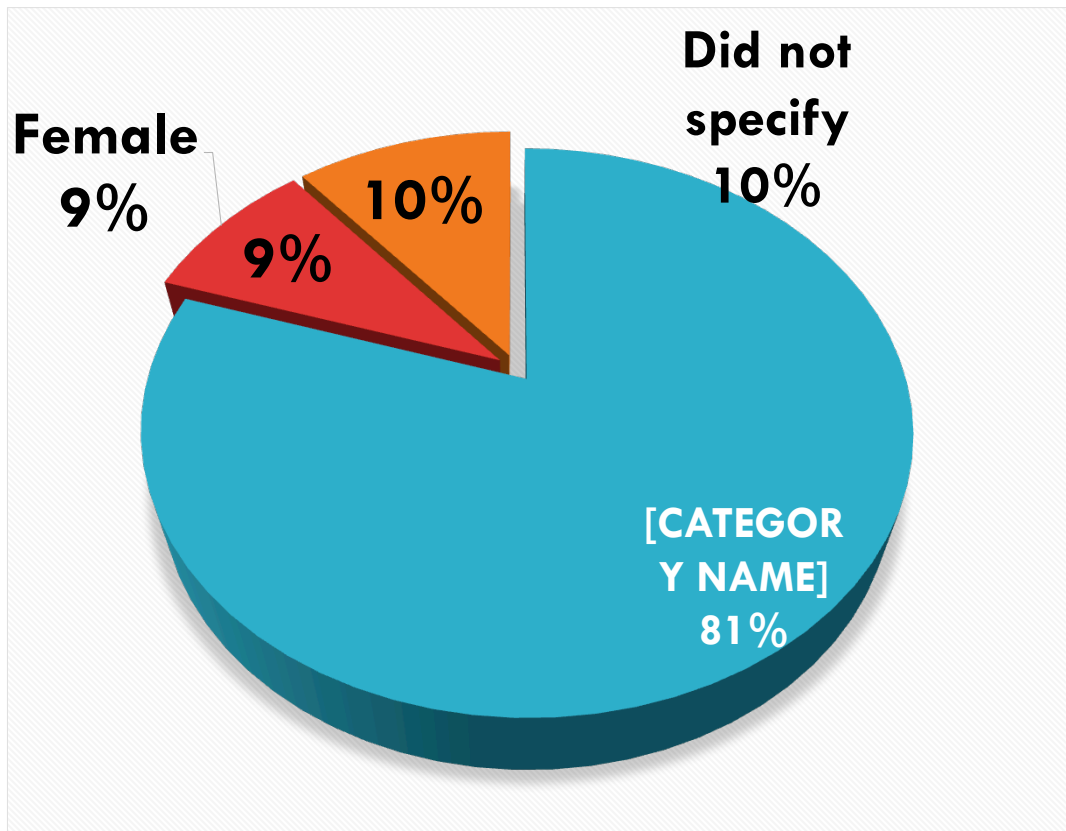


Effective this election cycle, the Society President will be elected **directly by our members**:
