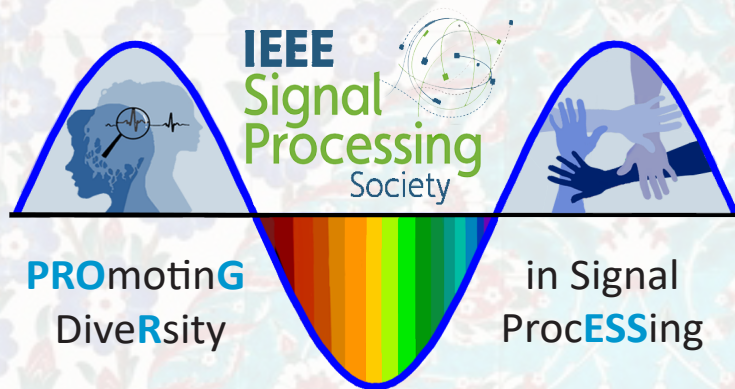


2020 IEEE SPS PROGRESS WORKSHOP
