- New TIP Website Area for Editorial Documents
 - Institutional memory
 - E.g. Streamlined paper handling document
 - E.g. EIC reports
- New Information Requested from Authors in S1M
 - What is contribution and why is it significant
 - What are most closely related existing papers and how different
 - Available to AEs and reviewers
- New Plagiarism Software Integrated into S1M and available to AEs
- New AEs
 - 14 new AEs since January 2013
 - 8 Pending AEs



Publications Board Related Activities

- Final page budget for 2013 is 5425 (2 queue releases: 700, 425)
- Page budget approved for 2014 is 5750 (~38 papers/issue)
- New SPS Plagiarism Policies
 - New policy emphasizes responsibility of all authors
 - Expressly calls out research misconduct
 - Expressly discusses self-plagiarism. Multiple submissions
 - Process requires committee evaluation and recommendation
 - Note: Prohibited authors list
- Standardized journal home pages
- In process:
 - Reduce the review cycle (4 vs 6 weeks for revisions)
 - Improved reviewer score sheet





Challenges for the future/Projects

- Submission growth (discussion later)
 - Paper backlog: 150 in Jan down to "10s" now
 - Receive about 120 manuscripts/month
 - Need efficient management of papers
 - Senior Area Editors under discussion.
- Quality/Impact
 - Acceptance rates need to reduce
 - Faster paper turn around
 - Increase in immediate rejects (when warranted)
- Plagiarism
 - 11 Cases of author misconduct since January
 - New SPS Policies a burden
 - Dedicated plagiarism team under discussion
- S1M is frustrating!
- Initiative on ML based paper matching (vs EDICS based)



2012 Submissions by Country



Yearly submissions for top 10 countries 2008-2012




Note: China 50/year increase until 2012, then 100/year increase!



Acceptances by Country (Top 10)


Acceptances by year for top 10 countries 2008-2012

Responses

- Strategic discussion at Publication Board
- Increase in immediate rejection of poor papers
- Reduce use of AEs and reviewers for paper refinement
 - Authors write papers, not AEs/Reviewers
 - Stick to our policies 2 full rounds of review max!
- Move to senior area editors for paper triage, improved matching
- Improved software for paper matching U. Toronto system discussions



Requests of AEs

- Thank you for your hard work. It makes a difference!
- Timeliness in paper handling
 - Don't get behind. Its harder to reject a paper you've sat on for a month!
- Streamline paper handling, prevent burnout
 - Immediate rejection option → eliminate poor papers at outset
 - Limit revisions → Only one major round of revision. Its our policy!
- Acceptance ratio creeping up → need to push back down
 - Are papers "significant"? Delicate issue!
